Responsibility

The Governance Board is responsible for:

1. The Society's strategic direction
2. Key policy;
3. Financial oversight;
4. Risk oversight;
5. Real estate oversight; and
6. Any other matters not covered by the Constitution or any Bylaws, policy or procedure adopted under the Constitution from time to time.

19.3 Eligibility for election as Non-Executive Officer

- (a) In order to be eligible for election as a Non-Executive Officer, a person must have:
 - (i) been a Member in Good Standing for three consecutive years or more; and
 - (ii) have:
 - (A) demonstrated a deep understanding of Theosophy
 - (B) demonstrated leadership skills; and
 - (C) skills in at least three of the following areas:
 - (I) strategy and planning;
 - (II) governance;
 - (III) finance;
 - (IV) legal; and
 - (V) communications and interpersonal skills.
- (b) For the avoidance of doubt, Honorary Members and Associate Members are not eligible for election as a Non-Executive Officer.

Police Check

A candidate cannot stand for this role if they have a criminal record. To verify this, a Police or Ministry of Justice check is required before your nomination can be approved which is completed once nominations close.

Personal Details

Candidates are to provide with their nomination, using the **Election Acceptance Form** (this form) and any associated forms, on one A4 page, a short statement of their background which includes a summary of what they bring to the position sought, a brief visionary statement, previous experience and any relevant experience in leadership, finance, governance, strategy and policy development or similar leadership and business skills. These details will be included in the ballot paper
